Unit Three – Programming with Python

During this unit you will complete and submit six program files to Autolab.

The first five (LOOP G1-G4 and FILE G1) each consist of one function. Autolab will return a score of 0 or 1 and that is the value towards this Unit Grade

The last file (FILE G2) consists of three functions. Autolab will return a score of 0, 0.3, 0.7, or 1 depending on how many of the three functions are working. This will be translated by me to a score from 0 to 3.

Thus, you will have the possibility of 8 points at the end of this Unit.

This unit is scheduled to officially end on Friday, December 8th. All programs must be submitted for the first time by that date.

Final resubmissions to correct deficiencies will be accepted through Friday, December 15th. After that deadline your Unit 3 activity grade will be assigned as follows:
